Warbler Road & Area Warbler Road Is a series of roads in western Virginia known to produce many species of Warblers Start from the Blue Ridge Parkway at the Sunset Field Overlook, milepost 78.4 Follow 812 for 5.8 miles. Turn left and follow 768 for 2.7 miles. Turn right on 59 (paved) Follow 59 for 2.9 miles then turn right on 614 (paved). Follow 614 for 1.6 miles to the James River. Most Birders agree that the 812, 768 roads are very productive. Other areas may also yield many Warblers and other species. By driving, stopping and listening you can BIRD without venturing far from your car.
